2017 SaDSA Championships

Saturday 11th and Saturday 25th November 2017

Time: Warm up 5.30pm; Racing 6.00 to 8.30pm

Venue: Bridlington Leisure centre

These Championships are open to all swimmers, 9 years and over, who have represented their club in any SaDSA Gala (Friendly Gala, Border League or Ridings League) in 2017.

The events will be swum in two sessions as shown below:

Each swimmer is initially restricted to a maximum of **three** events in each session; this will be opened up if space/time permits. Maximum session length is 2 hours 30 minutes.

As with all League Galas, age is as at 31st December 2017.

Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the following age groups: 9 yrs, 10 yrs, 11yrs, 12 yrs, 13 yrs, 14 yrs and 15+ yrs, and(if enough entries) in two categories: Cat A and Cat B.

Cat B cut off times will be finalised after entries close.

Entries are open; the closing date is 28th October or earlier if full.

Entries must be accompanied by at least 3 named gala officials/helpers for each session, along with their preferred roles. We need a minimum of 35 officials for each session - Referees, Starters, Judges, Timekeepers, Announcers, Front Desk, Stewards, Results and Awards.

Clubs can send entries in small batches if they wish. Entries will be processed in the order received. Fees must be received by 1st November.

Two team manager passes will be provided for each club (1 male and 1 female); additional passes will be allocated in proportion to the number of swimmers.

Entry Fees: £3.00 per event

Spectators: £2.00 per session
